ENROLLED ORDINANCE 172-044

APPROVE ORCHARD RIDGE LANDFILL EASTERN EXPANSION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 289.33 Wisconsin Statutes, Waukesha County has been participating as an "affected municipality" in the negotiation process with Waste Management, Inc. and the Village of Menomonee Falls for the proposed Eastern Expansion of the Orchard Ridge Landfill; and

WHEREAS, affected municipalities have representation on a "local committee" to negotiate with the owner of the landfill for a solid waste disposal facility license on matters concerning the location, design, construction, operation, closing and long-term care of the facility; and

WHEREAS, through Enrolled Ordinance 158-143, the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors approved an agreement that was negotiated by a local committee in 2004 for the Orchard Ridge Landfill Southern Expansion ("2004 Agreement"), which was amended and approved by the County Board in 2008 (Amendment #1) and 2009 (Horizontal & Vertical Expansions) through Enrolled Ordinances 163-65 and 163-072 respectively; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2017, the local committee for the Eastern Expansion of the Orchard Ridge Landfill voted 5-0 to recommend applying the amended version of the 2004 Agreement to the Eastern Expansion with further amendments, as briefly summarized below:

- (1) Increase landfill capacity through the Eastern Expansion by an estimated 5.5 million tons (5.5 years) plus 9.7 million tons (9.7 years) for the planned exhumation and reconstruction of the previously closed Boundary Road Landfill;
- (2) Improve vector and odor control efforts, especially during the exhumation process;
- (3) Provide copies of all state landfill reports and related correspondence to the affected municipalities;
- (4) Require the per ton host fee to increase annually by 3%;
- (5) Increase Waukesha County's share of total host fees collected from 5% to 10%;
- (6) Require removal of a drive-through culvert under County Line Road and road repair; and

WHEREAS, the Menomonee Falls Village Board approved the above noted amendments to the 2004 Agreement on September 18, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Waukesha County staff have reviewed and support the proposed amendments to the 2004 Agreement for the East Expansion, recognizing that all other provisions of the 2004 Agreement and previously approved amendments remain in effect, including the continuation of annual payments to Waukesha County of \$40,000 to support residential electronics recycling.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WAUKESHA COUNTY ORDAIN that the agreement for the Eastern Expansion of the Orchard Ridge Landfill, as approved by the local committee and on file in the Office of the County Clerk, is hereby approved, and the County Clerk and the County Executive shall sign the agreement on behalf of Waukesha County.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all revenues collected under this agreement shall be used to offset Waukesha County costs for solid waste, household hazardous waste, and recycling programs or other Department of Parks and Land Use operations and capital expenditures.

FISCAL NOTE

APPROVE ORCHARD RIDGE LANDFILL EASTERN EXPANSION AGREEMENT

This ordinance approves the agreements negotiated by the County and affected municipalities to expand the capacity of the Orchard Ridge solid waste disposal facility, estimated by department management to be completed in year 2019. Under the agreement, the County would receive an increase of 5% to 10% of the tonnage fee for the facility, which in 2017 is approximately \$4.40/ton. The rate increases annually by 3%. The County will continue to receive \$40,000 for a residential electronics recycling program.

The total revenue received at this facility in any given year will fluctuate based on the amount of material received. The proposed 2018 budget includes landfill fees under the current agreement. The additional revenue will begin on the date disposal begins in the Eastern Expansion, estimated to occur in 2019. The increase in revenue, estimated at \$175,000 for a full year at current tonnages, could be appropriated in the annual budget process to offset County costs for operations and capital expenditures within the Department of Parks and Land Use.

This ordinance results in no new direct tax levy impact in the 2018 budget.
